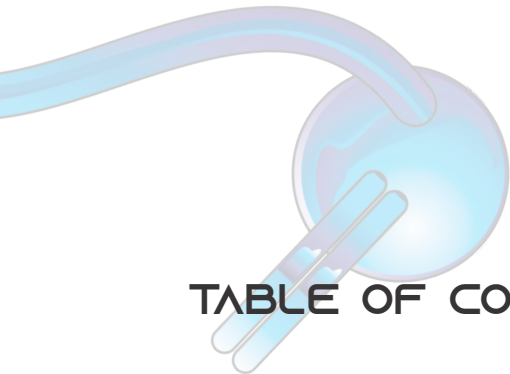

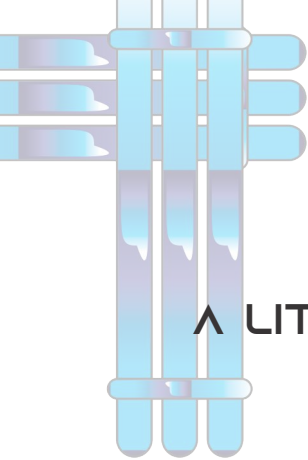
So, don't tell me I didn't warn you, okay!
